

Yanjun Shang is an Engineering geologist from Institute of Geology, Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS). He got his M.Sc. in Structural Geology and Geophysics at the Nanjing University and his Ph.D. in Hydrogeology and Engineering Geology at the Institute of Geology, CAS in 1997. He has carried out more than 10 consulting projects on engineering site selection, geohazards investigation, and identification of unfavorable geological bodies, e.g. soft rocks and hard soils for classification of geomaterials so as to predict the construction triggered hazards. He has published more than 160 papers in Chinese and English and is the author of 2 books. As a member of IAEG and of ISRM, he was the keynote speaker in many conferences in China and other countries. In 2006 he obtained the *Richard Wolters* prize of the IAEG.
