Articles are to follow the structure outlined below.

Title (14p, Times New Roman)

The full name of the author (12p, Times New Roman)

The affiliation and address (10p, Times New Roman)

1. Title of the section (depending on your topic)

Information, opinion and/or story can be explained. Here, any supporting evidence, quotations and/or statements from people relevant to the story can be included. In the main text, the author may choose to share only his/her opinions and experiences. References in the main text are not mandatory, however, if it is obligatory in terms of ethics, please refer to any kind of reference such as journal articles, popular science papers, news, etc. (avoid too many references).

Figures: One or two figures can be used and numbered successively. If the figure is taken from a website or an article, it should be added to the references.

2. Title of the section (depending on your closing statement)

This paragraph will round off the article nicely either with a conclusion, quote, or statement.

Page Limit: 2-3 pages
